| 1 | Discussion took place regarding the feasibility study on the potential expansion to the existing pavilion and relocation of external public toilets and the addition of an external Disabled unisex toilet.  |
| 2 | There may be asbestos in the building although previous works on the internals of the building did not reveal any concerns and, the building may be an old army hut from the end of WW2. It was agreed though that an asbestos management survey will be carried out if the proposal was to be progressed.   |
| 3 | The figures that came out of the feasibility study showed that £210k was an anticipated budget based on a standard layout which was nominally split as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• £140k for the Bowling club aspect of the project</li> <li>• £70k for the Public toilet aspect of the project</li> </ul>   |
| 4 | Andy Edwards advised that external funding opportunities are not normally be available to the Council but, the bowling club would be able to do this in order to secure funds for the project  |
| 5 | Potential Disability funding was suggested by Cllr Tom Wye   |
